The Gospel Is for All!

In Mark 16.15, before Jesus went back to Heaven, He gave the commission for His disciples to “Go into all the world and preach the Gospel to every creature.” As His disciples today, we have the same responsibility to fulfill that commission. Notice, specifically, that Jesus said to go to “every creature.” Truly, says Jesus, the Gospel is for all!

Nothing bears this out any better than John chapters 3 and 4. In chapter 3, a man named Nicodemus (a ruler of the Jews and a Pharisee) came to Jesus, and Jesus shared His “good news” with him. Obviously, the one to whom Jesus talked was a man, a Jew, well educated, and evidently an upper class individual and highly moral person. But, Jesus shared the Gospel with him because, you see, the Gospel is for all!

In chapter 4, a woman was asked by Jesus to give Him some water from Jacob’s well. She was a woman, a Samaritan, evidently unlearned, of the lower class and highly immoral person (she had 5 husbands in the past and was living with one to whom she was not married). But, Jesus shared the good news with her as well. Why? It is because the Gospel is for all!

The point is this: no matter what your gender, race, educational level, social status or moral situation, the Gospel is for you! We all sin and we all need the Gospel (Rom. 1.16, 3.23, 6.23, et al.). We sing a song entitled, “The Gospel Is For All.” In the chorus of that song there is a phrase that supports the point of this article. It says, “Where sin has gone must go His grace, the Gospel is for all.” We all sin, we all need God’s grace and we all need the Gospel! And, let each of us thank God that the Gospel is for all! Think about it!
