The 2018 Convention will be held March 30-April 1, 2018. The theme is “In Remembrance of Me” 1 Cor. 11:24-25.

If you are interested in doing Lads this year, please be present Sunday evening! Below is some general information about our program. However, more information, including the 2017 Official Event Rule Book, is available at lads2leaders.com.

Costs and Deadlines. Registration fees due. (3rd Grade – Adult; \$40 per person)(Kindergarten – 2nd Grade; No Fee if only participating in Oral Bible Reading, Song Leading, Songs of Praise or Speech.\$40 per person if participating in these and other activities)

- * **January 7th** Registration Fees Due.
- * **January 15th** Pre-Convention Events Submitted(Mass Media events,...etc)
- * **January 19th** Speeches Finalized
(Feb 25th Speeches Memorized)
- * **February 15th** Hotel Registration Due
- * **February 17th** Pearls and Bible Bowl Test dates; posted marked by *Feb 20th*.
- * **March 19th** Hotel Fees Due at local level. (\$117 per night plus valet service tax equals \$157.77 per night)

We are also making a concerted effort to have all pre-convention and year around events finished by this January 15 deadline. These events must be verified at this time. This will help the students, the event leaders, and everyone involved. We really want to use the months of January, February, and March to focus on the convention events.

The Plan for Sunday. In the foyer on Sunday morning, there will be packets available for participants to pick up. Each packet will contain lots of information including some registration forms. We ask that each family pick up only one packet. There will be enough forms in the packet for a family of four. If you need more forms, they will be available in the foyer. Please look these over on Sunday afternoon and bring them back on Sunday evening filled out (or at least mostly filled out). This will save lots of time on Sunday evening. On Sunday evening we will discuss various aspects of the Lads to Leaders program, and provide some motivation to sign up for various events. Thanks in advance for your help!

Who Is Needed: student participants (students preschool-high school who wish to participate in various events), adult participants (adults who are willing to serve as a judge in a specific event), event leaders (adults who are willing oversee/organize a selected event throughout the year), adult volunteers (adults who wish to assist with the program but cannot serve as an event leader or adult participant), mentors (adults who wish to help student participants set and attain their goals throughout the year), and chaperones (adults who are willing to attend convention and be responsible for some of our young people).
