### Jesus Calms The Sea! Mark 4:35-41

“And the same day, when the even was come, he saith unto them, Let us pass over unto the other side. And when they had sent away the multitude, they took him even as he was in the ship. And there were also with him other little ships. And there arose a great storm of wind, and the waves beat into the ship, so that it was now full. And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish? And he arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, Peace, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. And he said unto them, Why are ye so fearful? how is it that ye have no faith? And they feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea obey him?”

# Jesus Wept

It is one of the shortest passages in the entire Bible. The passage contains only two words. In the English rendering it contains only nine letters. The passage? John 11.35, "Jesus Wept."

Jesus and His disciples were beyond the Jordan in the place where John the immerser was initially baptizing people. While there, Jesus heard that his dear friend, Lazarus (brother of Mary and Martha), was sick. Ironically, He stayed where He was for two more days. When He told the disciples that it was time to go to Lazarus in Judea, He also informed them that Lazarus had died. By the time they got to Judea Lazarus had been in the tomb for four days.

There is every indication in the text that Jesus knew that He was going to raise Lazarus from the dead. He said, "This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God may be glorified through it (v. 4)." He also said, "Our friend Lazarus sleeps, but I go that I may wake him up (v. 11)." When Jesus met Martha He simply said, "Your brother will rise again (v. 23)."

When Jesus saw Mary weeping He "groaned in the spirit and was troubled" (v. 33). And, when He came to the tomb in which Lazarus had been placed we read the words, "Jesus wept" (v. 35). The question is why did He weep? It is not because of the death of Lazarus; rather it is because of the grief and heartache that Mary and others were experiencing.

Now think about that. Heb. 4.15 says about Jesus, "For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin." The point? When we are in any type of grief, sadness, loneliness, heartache, and such like, we have One Who can sympathize with us. It is Jesus, Himself! Be encouraged!
