Luke 17:11-19

"And it came to pass, as he went to Jerusalem, that he passed through the midst of Samaria and Galilee. And as he entered into a certain village, there met him ten men that were lepers, which stood afar off: And they lifted up *their* voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have mercy on us. And when he saw *them*, he said unto them, Go shew yourselves unto the priests. And it came to pass, that, as they went, they were cleansed. And one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, and with a loud voice glorified God, And fell down on *his* face at his feet, giving him thanks: and he was a Samaritan. And Jesus answering said, Were there not ten cleansed? but where *are* the nine? There are not found that returned to give glory to God, save this stranger. And he said unto him, Arise, go thy way: thy faith hath made thee whole. "

What Kind of Responses Did Jesus Get?

When we read about the life of Jesus in Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John it might seem that Jesus received great results from His teaching others. For example, in Matt. 4.18-20, He saw Peter and Andrew fishing. He told them to follow Him and He would make them “fishers of men.” They immediately left their work and followed Him. In Matt. 13.1ff, so many people came to hear Jesus that He had to get into a boat. In John 12.12ff, a “great multitude” went out to meet Him with palm branches. It would appear that Jesus, the Master Teacher, always had great results from His teaching others.

But, wait! There are times when His teachings were not received in such a positive light. Consider the following...

1. In Luke 18.18ff, a certain ruler asked Jesus what He needed to do to inherit eternal life. Jesus told Him to sell all of his riches and help the poor. He went away sorrowful!
2. In Matt. 13.53ff, after Jesus taught in parables, many were “offended at Him” because they viewed Him simply as a man (Joseph and Mary’s son). Because of their unbelief, Jesus did not do miracles there.
3. On another occasion, when Jesus was teaching in parables in Matt. 21, the Pharisees “sought to lay hands on Him” because they believed that He was talking about them.

So, you see, Jesus was often rejected for His teaching of the Truth, but He kept right on doing it! This can be a valuable lesson for each of us. You see, we may often avoid teaching and talking to others because of fear of rejection. If that happens, then we should remember that we are in good company! If Jesus could not convert some, it is sure that we will not either. But, like Jesus, we need to keep right on teaching, for some will listen!
