A Good Mother

A good mother understands the PRIVILEGE of motherhood. Surely, this goes without saying. All one has to do is consider those who could not have children, but who were later able to do so. Biblically, those would include women such as Sarah (Gen. 16), Rebekah (Gen. 25), Rachel (Gen. 30), Hannah (1 Sam. 1), and Elisabeth (Luke 1). When a woman wants a child and is unable to conceive, it really makes her more appreciative when she does have one!

A good mother understands the POTENTIAL of motherhood.

That potential is realized by the great influence that a mother has on her children. The Bible is explicit in revealing this aspect. Consider Eze. 16.44, "Like mother, like daughter." Solomon suggested that we "not forsake the law of your mother" (Pro. 1.8). Paul wrote of the influence that Timothy's grandmother and mother had on him concerning his faith (2 Tim. 1.5). The influence of a mother on her children is tremendous!

A good mother understands the PASSION of motherhood. This passion can be seen in the extent to which mothers will go in their love for their children. Jochebed, mother of Moses, put him in a basket in the Nile River to save him (Ex. 2.3). The true mother in Solomon's judgement was willing to give up her child in order to save the child's life (1 Kings 3.26). The love that mothers have for their children is often the most pure and unselfish of all loves!

A good mother understands the PERSEVERANCE of motherhood. This concerns what a mother will endure with her children. Mary, the mother of Jesus, is a good example. When Jesus was born, Simeon told her that "a sword will pierce through your own soul" (Luke 2.35), which ultimately included the crucifixion of her Son! The things that mothers endure can be tremendous! Think about it!
