## Receiving and Giving Comfort

The apostle Paul wrote, “Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God” (2 Cor. 1.3,4). Let us ask and answer two questions about this passage.

Question #1: What does it mean that “God comforts us in all our tribulation?”

God comforts (consoles, encourages) us in ALL our tribulation. Whatever your trouble, affliction, or distress in life, God can and will comfort you during that time. And, He has the capability of doing it during every single distressing event, no matter what we are having to endure.

Question #2: What does it mean that “we may be able to comfort those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God?”

Since we receive comfort from God in our trying times in life, those very experiences can be used by us to help “those who are in any trouble!” That makes sense, does it not? If you are having trouble with your children acting out, does it not make sense that you would seek help from someone else who has had the same type of problem with their own children and have overcome the problem? Sure it does!

That being said, each of us has our own “experience” with God comforting us in trials. Should we not use that to help others, both in and out of the church? If we have received comfort from “the God of all comfort”, we ought to extend comfort to others! Think about it, and look around to see whom you may help!
