Balance with the Bible: That We May Not Be Ashamed

Every person carries baggage when it comes to God's Word. I do and you do as well. There are things that I may desire to emphasize that you may not, and at the same time, there are things that you may desire to emphasize that I do not. We are encouraged to "contend earnestly for the faith" (Jude 3). Timothy, as well as us, was told by Paul to "accurately handle the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15). If care is not taken, while "contending earnestly" and "accurately handling" God's Word, a key ingredient can be missed. Paul addresses this in his letter to Ephesus, "but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow in all aspects into Him who is head, even Christ" (Ephesians 4:15). The church at Ephesus had fought false doctrine, tested false apostles, and worked hard for the Lord's sake, but Jesus had something against them. They had left their first love (Rev. 2:2-4). The love that they had at the beginning of their labor for the Lord, each other, and their fellow man, they no longer possessed. Because of this, Jesus commanded them to repent or else, He would remove their lampstand (Rev. 2:5). He would no longer recognize them as His. While we are not the church in Ephesus, we can and should learn from the message given them. Let us be willing to put down the baggage we are carrying when it comes to God's Word. Yes, let us strive to accurately handle God's Word. Yes, let us be willing to contend earnestly for the faith. However, let us remember we are not here to be argument winners, but soul winners. Let us be people who temper our zeal for God's Word by our love for Him, our fellow man, and especially the family of God. By doing this, we can stand before God without shame, approved by Him.
