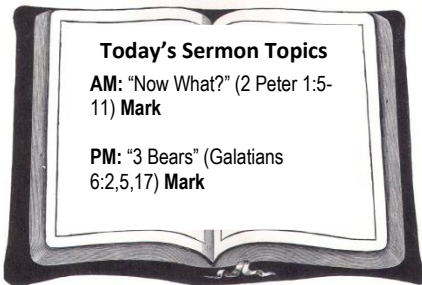

Love Is A Badge

When you watch old western movies, you could always identify the good guy and the bad guy. The good guy would wear a white hat, and the bad guy would wear a black hat. The good guy was usually the sheriff, so he would also wear a badge. The badge is a symbol used for identification. Jesus in essence told His followers that love is the badge of discipleship (John 13:34-35). He said that the world would identify His followers by their love. He qualified that love with “as I have loved you.” This can be intimidating on the surface, but it is Jesus’ commandment (John 15:12). Jesus also said, “Greater love has no one than this, than to lay down one’s life for his friends. This is a self-sacrificing type of love. Let us wear this badge as the body of Christ, the family of God, and the bride of Christ. As Paul stated in his inspired letter to Colosse, “Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also must do. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection.” Grace and peace! I love you all!
