Remarks From Mark

Article: "The Problem with the World Today (pt. 1)"

If you were asked what is wrong with the world today, what would you say? There would probably be a multitude of answers. Some might say gay rights, abortion, child molesters, drunkenness, pornography, etc. Those are just symptoms of a much greater problem. In order to find a solution to the problem, we must find its root. I believe the root of the problem facing us today falls into two categories. We will address one this Sunday and the second next Sunday. The first is a misunderstanding of love. In our society, we are told that if you tell me I am wrong, then you don't love me. True love, the agape kind, seeks the best for another regardless of whether they like it or not. For example, if a child was about to walk out into oncoming traffic, would you set there and watch the tragedy unfold or would you stop them. Common sense tells us that we would do something if it were nothing more than yell at the top of our lungs, "STOP!" Agape love has a desire for God's will to be communicated to another, hence, "love...thinks no evil; does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth" (1 Cor. 13:5b-6). Therefore, if we see someone doing something that is detrimental to their spiritual welfare, then we tell them what God has to say about it with a spirit of love (Eph. 4:15). It is important to remember that just because people misuse love, it doesn't give us the right to get angry and forget the higher calling Jesus has given us. Let us be the people that truly love others and are willing to intervene when necessary in order to save people caught up in this world from spiritual death. Grace and peace to you! My love to all!
