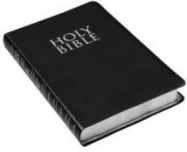

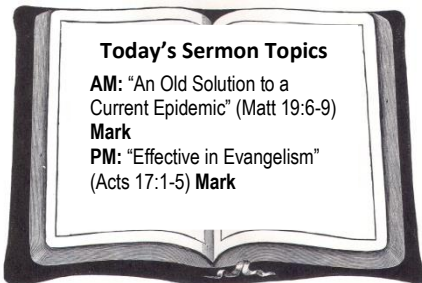

Article: Preaching Is Not Always Easy

Being a minister/preacher in the Lord's church is one of the greatest blessings anyone could have. However, it also comes with some heavy weights to carry. Many times people tell me that they know how I feel, but unless one is a preacher, they really don't. Sometimes, as ministers, we are caught in the middle of family quarrels, which are heart-breaking. Sometimes, we are with people who are in a great deal of emotional, mental, or physical pain and we hurt with them. People sometimes ask, "Why get that involved?" The only true answer I can think of is Jesus. He was compassionate (i.e. he hurt with them) therefore ministers should feel this way. As Christians though, shouldn't we all feel compassion for others, even those who we deem not worthy? Sometimes, there are sermons, such as this morning's message, which are difficult to preach, but as preachers we must preach the whole counsel of God and speak as the oracles of God (Acts 20:26-27; 1 Peter 4:11). As preachers, we can't apologize for this. Sometimes, there are members that you know need prayers for strength, repentance, or even to respond to the gospel, yet for one reason/excuse or another, they spurn the invitation. Again, many sleepless hours at night are spent over this. All of these things are not meant to sound like a desire for pity. It is just a quick glimpse into the heart of a preacher/minister who loves the people he works with. It is high time that we be more open and honest with each other. I have seen it starting, but let us allow it to grow. Remember God loves you and I do too! Grace and peace to you!
