Remarks From Mark

Article: “Surrender Please”

Many of us have heard the battle cry, “No retreat, no surrender!” Many movies portray that it is better to die than to surrender. The word “surrender” is not in the Bible, but the concept is. Every person is a walking civil war. The flesh is at odds with the spirit in each of us. Paul talks about this difficulty in Romans 7:13-25. However, in Romans 8:1-11, Paul gives the concept of surrendering our fleshly desires to the Spirit of God. It is a battle that is waged in the mind (2 Cor. 10:4-5). Surrender is not a neat, tidy package. It is often a package of hard feelings like anger, rage, and sadness. It can be painful, as we see ourselves as we truly are, with the emotions we deal with daily. As we surrender, we experience those emotions that we have felt towards others, ourselves, life, and even God. When we really surrender to God, the emotional, mental, even physical burdens we have been carrying are released and relief soon follows. Surrender puts the wheels in motion. Fear and worry about the future are released with surrender. We come to know God on a deeper level, realizing that we are protected, guided, and loved. Surrender allows us to move forward, because we have turned over all the things that were holding us back. We give them to God, because He has asked for them (1 Pet. 5:6-7). Please, do not be afraid of being uncomfortable, vulnerable, or even awkward. God doesn't mind and neither should His spiritual family. Let us be willing to surrender ourselves to God. Freedom waits on the other side!
