Remarks From Mark "I Would Rather Be A Vegetarian"

Here in the South many times people who only eat vegetables are frowned upon. We often have a main course of meat as well as meat in our vegetables for flavor. I enjoy a "pone" of cornbread, some butter beans, and fried okra. While growing up, when we had meals like this, our dessert would be an extra piece of cornbread smothered in the pot liquor (juice of the purple hull peas, butter beans, etc.). When we turn our attention to the wise, inspired sayings of the Proverbs, we find that a dinner of vegetables (herbs in some translations) is better than a dinner of a fatted calf (15:17). The latter dinner was typically consumed on a joyous occasion, but here it is looked down upon. Why is this? Love is better than hate! This may seem obvious to us, but is it reflected in our actions? How do we treat our enemies? Jesus gave the remedy for this, love (Luke 6:27-36). This is a simple statement, but profound in action. Another question, how do we treat our neighbor? Jesus gave the remedy for this, love (Mark 12:31). Yet another question, how do I treat my brothers and sisters in Christ? Jesus gave this answer for this also, love (John 13:34-35 cf. 1 John 3:14-15). How we treat our enemies, our neighbor, our brothers and sisters in Christ is a reflection of how we treat God (Mark 12:28-30). Remember, "Better is a dinner of vegetables where love is, than a fatted calf with hatred." Let us live our lives with so much love that there is no room for hate! I love you and more importantly God loves you!
