And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing. But Philip was found at Azotus: and passing through he preached in all the cities, till he came to Caesarea."

Remarks From Mark

Q & A with Jesus (pt. 1)

I thought it might be valuable, for the next few weeks, to examine some of the questions Jesus was asked while here on earth and His response. These will be done in a random fashion. (Matt. 9:11 Q) *“Why is your Teacher eating with tax collectors and sinners?”* (Matt. 9:12 A) *“The healthy do not need a physician, but those who are sick.”* In the first part of His answer, Jesus gave a very simple physical illustration to teach a spiritual lesson. Healthy people physically do not seek a doctors help, but sick people do. The Pharisees, who considered themselves spiritually whole, would not seek the care of Jesus, who is the great Physician of the soul. They were blind to their sinful state. (Matt. 13a A) *“Go and learn what this means, ‘I desire mercy and not sacrifice’.”* In the second part of His answer Jesus rebukes them by appealing to the prophet Hosea (6:6). Jesus used the Pharisee’s own formula “go and learn” to teach them another lesson. This implied inadequate knowledge of the very law they were teaching. The Pharisees were satisfied with their rituals, but their hearts were not right with God. The very Scriptures they were teachers of condemned them. They needed to have pity and compassion on those who were lost, but they were smug and arrogant in their own self-righteousness. (Matt. 13b A) *“I did not come to call the righteous to repentance, but sinners.”* Jesus was not implying that the Pharisees were righteous, not by a long shot. Jesus was pointing out that He, the Great Physician, was offering an invitation for spiritual healing, but that they, the Pharisees, did not even recognize their own spiritual decay and need for the healing only Jesus could provide. We too, if we are not careful, can adopt this attitude that we are so righteous that we don’t need Jesus’ healing. If we truly recognize our daily need for Jesus, it will help us to be more compassionate toward the lost of this dying world and their need for the blood of Jesus. I love you all!
