Remarks From Mark Q & A with Jesus (pt. 2)

If we had one opportunity to ask Jesus a question, what would it be? It would be a tough decision. There are so many things we would like to know. As we continue to look at questions that Jesus was confronted with and His response to them, let us examine the set of questions in (Matt. 13:54-56). (Q) "Where did this man get this wisdom and these mighty works? Is not this the carpenter's son? Is not His mother called Mary? And His brothers James, Joses, Simon, and Judas? And His sisters, are they not all with us? Where then did this man get all these things? (A) "A prophet is not without honor except in his own country and in his own house." All of the questions which were posed earlier boiled down to familiarity. The Jews from the synagogue along with Jesus' own family had great difficulty comprehending that Jesus was who He claimed to be because they had witnessed His childhood and upbringing. It was not that Jesus was bad child or that Joseph and Mary didn't raise Him right. The brief glimpse we have of Jesus' childhood refutes this (Luke 2:25-52). It is possible that part of the reason for their unbelief was that they bought into all the negativity about their village Nazareth. (John 1:46) Nathanael asked, "Can anything good come from Nazareth?" Whatever the case, they should have known that the Messiah would have been called a Nazarene (Matt. 2:23). They were offended because of this, and as a result there were very few who came to Him for healing. A lesson from this for us, is we too can be ineffective for the Lord if we believe that we have to be in a famous area to promote faith in Christ. It is not the city we are trying to win for the Lord, but its inhabitants. Also, the Jews should have recognized Jesus as the Messiah, because of the Scriptures that they studied testified of Him. However, they came to the Scriptures with their own agenda (John 5:37-40). This should show us the importance of coming to God's Word with an honest heart, lest Jesus marvel at our unbelief as well (Mark 6:6). I love you all! Grace and peace to you!
