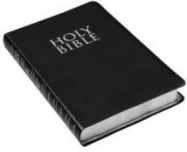

Remarks From Mark

Q & A with Jesus (pt. 3a)

The question we will examine today comes from a rich, young ruler (Matt. 19:20; Luke 18:18). Because of the nature of Jesus' answer, this will be broken down into two parts. He asked Jesus a very important question, "Good Teacher, what [good thing] shall I do that I may inherit eternal life?" (Matt. 19:16; Mark 10:17) Jesus' answer contained a question, "Why do you call me good? No one is good but One, that is, God." First of all the young man seemed to be implying that he wanted to find the one good thing he could do to have eternal life and be done with it. Sometimes it is tempting to fall for the idea of doing one thing (e.g. being baptized) and being on the fast track to heaven. As Christians, we are doers of God's word (James 1:22-25). We labor to demonstrate our faith, lest our faith be lifeless (James 2:14-26). We cannot do anything to earn eternal life, and especially not one thing as this young man mistakenly believed (Eph. 2:8-10), but we sure can forfeit our salvation by not laboring for the Lord (John 15:1-8). Back to Jesus' answer, it is very perplexing on the surface. Is Jesus really claiming not to be good? Of course He is not! God is good as Jesus states, but Jesus was God in the flesh (Col. 2:9). It seems as though Jesus was testing this young ruler, who was a Jew, as evidenced by his knowledge of the Mosaic Law (Mark 10:19-20). Did he see Jesus for who He was, Deity? His response to Jesus indicates that though he knew the OT scriptures, which pointed to Jesus, he did not recognize Him for who He was. We have all the inspired Word of God today, which not only points to Jesus living as a man, it reveals exactly what we can do to please Him. Let us recognize Jesus for the example He left us (John 13:1-17; 2 Pet. 2:21ff). Let us strive to be true servants of His! I love all of you! Grace and peace to you!
