

Remarks From Mark Q & A with Jesus (pt. 3b)

This morning's article will resume with the situation Jesus faced with the rich young ruler as recorded in (Matt. 19:16-26; Mark 10:17-27; Luke 18:18-27). We examined part of Jesus' answer as He tested the young ruler's identity of Him and the fact that this young man implied that he could do one thing and receive eternal life. It is wonderful to know that even though this young man was mistaken about the Christ, Jesus still loved Him (Mark 10:21). Jesus looked directly into this man's heart, and knew that he had a problem that is very common today, love of possessions (Mark 10:21-22 cf. 1 Tim. 6:9-10). We can see as Paul expounds to Timothy, it is not a sin to be rich, but it is a sin to make the pursuit of riches a top priority. Jesus gives a proverb, which was common to them, to show the impossibility of those who love wealth to enter the kingdom. Yes, He is actually saying it is as impossible for a camel to go through a needle's eye (Luke's Greek word was a surgical needle, while Matthew's was a sewing needle) as for a rich man to enter heaven. There are those who have tried to weaken this argument by saying the "eye of the needle" was a narrow gate in Jerusalem or a tight mountain pass (the Greek language doesn't even remotely imply this), but it is evident that Jesus' disciples got the gravity of the statement by their question, "Who then can be saved?" We need to understand that the person who lives for and trusts in his riches, like this young ruler, will find it impossible to inherit eternal life. Sometimes we can get comfortable and think that since we are physically blessed in this life, we are right with God. Some who are not as well off can think that of others as well, but this is faulty thinking. Jesus' final saying offers hope even to the wealthy, "All things are possible with God!" If we have the proper attitude about our wealth, we will be willing to sacrifice it if called to, as God desires. If we do not, then our eternal fate will be like that of the rich young ruler. Let us not allow material things to stand between us and the eternal life, which our Lord has called us to. I love you all! Grace and peace to you!
