Remarks From Mark

Q & A with Jesus (pt.4)

The question under Jesus' consideration today comes from Nicodemus as recorded in (John 3:4). Nicodemus was a ruler of the Pharisees, a teacher of Israel (vs.1, 10). Most likely, he was member of the Sanhedrin council (Jewish Supreme Court). It is very possible that he was one of the many who believed in the name of Jesus (John 2:23). We do not know why exactly that he came at night (v.2). Many speculate about this, but we will not here. Nicodemus was impressed by the signs which Jesus had performed and his confidence that God must be with Jesus for this to happen (v.2). Jesus could see in Nicodemus a different attitude than the other Pharisees (John 2:24-25). He had a thirst for true knowledge. What triggers the question from Nicodemus is the statement of Jesus, "Truly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (v.3). Nicodemus' question came in two parts: "How can a man be born when he is old?" and "Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" (v.4) Nicodemus was not being sarcastic. He truly did not understand this teaching of Jesus. Jesus clarifies both questions with His answer, "Truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom" (v.5). This is a clear allusion to baptism, and the power of obedience from a faithful heart. Many other verses make it clear that when we are baptized, we are regenerated by the Holy Spirit and become a new creation in Christ. Please check these scripture references (Titus 3:3-5; Acts 2:38; Gal. 3:26-27; Rom. 6:3-6; 2 Cor. 5:17). To become part of an earthly family one must be born, but to be part of the spiritual family of God requires a birth from above (v.5). Let us, like Jesus told Nicodemus, not be surprised, nor ashamed of this command of God (v.6). Baptism, the spiritual new birth, is essential to being part of the spiritual family of God, the Lord's church (Acts 2:41, 47). God loves you and so do I! Grace and peace to you!
