## Remarks From Mark

### Q & A with Jesus (pt.5)

The question we will briefly examine this morning from (Mark 5:1-20) is actually not recorded as a question. To set the stage, Jesus has just cast out a demon named Legion (made of many) from a man who was living in the tombs of the country of the Gadarenes (Gerasenes in some versions). The people of the region were very afraid when they saw the formerly demon-possessed man in his right mind, as well as, their witness of the herd of 2,000 swine, in which the demon entered, violently running off a cliff to their death. They were so afraid that they asked Jesus to leave their region. What a missed opportunity for them! The young man, who was formerly possessed, had a different attitude. He had the attitude of gratitude! Sadly today, many in the Lord's church do not display their gratefulness to the Lord and it shows by refusing to obey the gospel, one service only attendance, complaining about the leadership of the church, not sharing the gift of Jesus with others, etc. The young man who was healed, begged Jesus to go with Him! I can hear him now, "Can I please, please, please go with You?" Jesus' answer was, "No." However, Jesus had a mission for Him to go and tell about the great things the Lord had done for him, along with the compassion shown him by the Lord. The young man did just that! He told ALL that Jesus had done for him to the extent that people were amazed regarding Jesus! Has Jesus done anything for you? You know He has, just like I know what He has done for me. Let us be the people, like this young man, to proclaim all the wonderful things the Lord has done for us, instead of moping around like we have no hope! If we are to be wrapped up in ourselves, it could be that we are asking Him to leave our region. There is no reason not to tell others about the One who gave His all for us! I love you all! God loves you! Grace and peace to you!
