

Remarks From Mark Q & A with Jesus (pt.5)

The question we will briefly examine this morning from (Mark 5:1-20) is actually not recorded as a question. To set the stage, Jesus has just cast out a demon named Legion (made of many) from a man who was living in the tombs of the country of the Gadarenes (Gerasenes in some versions). The people of the region were very afraid when they saw the formerly demonpossessed man in his right mind, as well as, their witness of the herd of 2,000 swine, in which the demon entered, violently running off a cliff to their death. They were so afraid that they asked Jesus to leave their region. What a missed opportunity for them! The young man, who was formerly possessed, had a different attitude. He had the attitude of gratitude! Sadly today, many in the Lord's church do not display their gratefulness to the Lord and it shows by refusing to obey the gospel, one service only attendance, complaining about the leadership of the church, not sharing the gift of Jesus with others, etc. The young man who was healed, begged Jesus to go with Him!
