Remarks From Mark

The God We Serve - Patient

We saw last week that it is important to know God, as pointed out by the apostle Paul (Acts 27:23). For a relationship to grow it is vital that each one involved know the other. God has revealed Himself through the Scriptures, so we can have the opportunity to know Him better. We will not examine the attributes of God in chronological order, but randomly. All the His' attributes are important, but the first we will examine is God's patience. This is revealed in (Rom. 15:5): "the God of patience." This attribute of God is so accurate. When you examine the Old Testament, it is easy to see the patience of God. He did so many wonderful, mighty works before the Israelites, yet they grumbled and complained against Him. Today, we can see the patience of God in dealing with this country and its rebellion against Him. We find that God is longsuffering, not willing that any should perish (2 Pet. 3:9). We find that Jesus gave us an example of patience even in suffering, that we could be more like Him (2 Pet. 2:20-24). As we continue to meditate on the patience of God as revealed in Scripture, it will help us be more patient as well (Rom. 15:4). Let us remember also, that God expects us to bear the fruit of His Spirit, one of which is patience (Gal. 5:22-23). Father, help us to be more grateful for the patience You have with us. Help us to be more grateful for the example of patience Your Son had in His suffering. Father, please help us to more patient with all those You have set before us! Grace and peace to all! I love you and God loves you too!
