## Remarks From Mark

### The God We Serve - Comfort

Last Sunday, we examined God's patience, as well as how it was demonstrated by His Son during His suffering. This Sunday let us examine the attribute of comfort as it pertains to God. Paul in addition to describing God as patient also describes Him as the God of comfort (Romans 15:5). The prophet Isaiah proclaimed comfort from God in one of the longest prophecies we have recorded in our Bibles (Isa. 40-66 specifically 40:1, 51:3). Ultimately, that comfort would come through the suffering servant, Jesus the Christ (Isa. 53). Today, many have the view that comfort is found in riches, but this is not the case. Many of the richest people on earth are miserable. True comfort can only be found in Christ (Phil. 2:1), as supplied by the "GOD of ALL COMFORT" (2 Cor. 1:3). We find here that God comforts us, His people, in all our troubles, and through this comfort He provides, we are to comfort others in their troubles (2 Cor. 1:4). God's comfort/consolation is mentioned 10 times in (2 Cor. 1:3-7). This is truly a comforting passage for Christians! So, do we truly believe God will comfort us, or do we revel in our afflictions, focusing on self? Let us seek the comfort that God supplies through His beloved Son. As God comforts us in our troubles, let us also seek to comfort others in their times of trial. Grace and peace to you! I love you and God loves you too!
