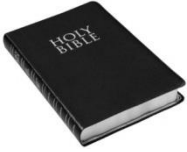

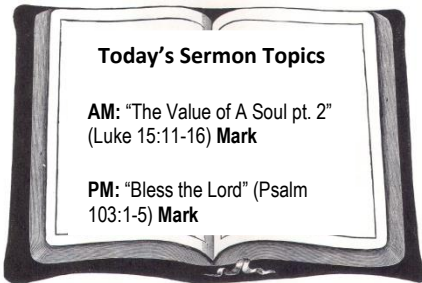

## Remarks From Mark

### The God We Serve - Mercy

So far, we have examined two attributes of God, patience and comfort, and how these should affect our lives. In Romans 15:9, we find that God is merciful. In this text, we see that God in the new covenant, as prophesied about in the old covenant, extends His mercy to the Gentiles as well as the Jews. That is important to us, because we are Gentiles. Because God is merciful, He does not give us what we deserve. We deserve punishment. We deserve death (Rom. 3:23; 6:23). Thanks be to God that He doesn't desire that we receive punishment (2 Peter 3:9). Since God has extended mercy to us, what should we extend to others? Jesus answered this for us in what we call the beatitudes. "Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy" (Matt. 5:7). The religious people of Jesus' day, especially the Pharisees, were sorely lacking in mercy. They needed instructions in regard to the weightier matters of the law, one of which was mercy (Matt. 23:23). I am so thankful and I'm sure you are as well that God is abundant in mercy, and that His mercy endures forever (Numb. 14:18; 1 Chron. 16:34). Let us go boldly before God's throne of mercy in prayer to receive the mercy we need (Heb. 4:16). Let us be people who are willing to extend mercy to others instead of judgment, because "mercy triumphs over judgment" (James 2:13). Remember if we do not extend mercy, we should not expect to receive it! Father, please help us to truly "love mercy" (Micah 6:8). Grace and peace to you! God loves you and I do too!
