

# Remarks From Mark The God We Serve – Hope (Romans 15:13)

We will again examine the God we serve, this time through the lens of hope. For Christians, it essential that we have a "living" hope. God is the source of this living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ (1 Pet. 1:3-5). Paul told the brethren in Corinth that if they only had hope in Christ in this life then they were the most pitiable people on earth (1 Cor. 15:19). Here in our verse, Paul tells the brethren in Rome the beauty of the hope which God supplies through faith (i.e. "believing"). Through hope the Christian has all joy and peace. Therefore, Paul wanted them to abound (grow) in this hope (excited expectation). For Christians, we cannot survive spiritually without this hope. We should be excited about serving God and as God's children; we should be excited about the thought of Jesus' return and our eternal salvation. We should expect God to keep His promise, because He confirmed it with an oath (Heb. 6:17-19). God has the power to save us, never forget that! Remember, this hope does not disappoint because of the love He has shown in giving us His Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13 cf. 5:5). Hope is as essential to our spiritual life as blood is to our physical bodies. Let us live like we earnestly expect to go to heaven, not because of the good we have done, but because of the promise made by God, who is the source of the "living" hope and our faith in Him. Remember God loves you and I do too! Grace and peace to you all!
