There are so many things we often take for granted and I'm afraid worship is one of these. While in Greenwood, I had a wakeup call to this very thing when I woke up a few Sundays sick. Not being able to come together with my brothers and sisters in Christ for worship threw off my whole week. Worship is one of the main ways we draw closer to our Creator. It encourages us to love more and do good works to bring God glory (Heb. 10:24; Matt. 5:16). Eugene Peterson put it this way, "Worship does not satisfy our hunger for God; it whets our appetite." Judson Cornwall had this to say about worship, "There are entire congregations who worship praise and praise worship but who have not yet learned to praise and worship God in Jesus Christ." Worship is not about us, but about the one who knows us better than we know ourselves. Let us have our priorities correct when we come to worship recognizing the privilege that only we as Christians have. The Bible ends in the book of Revelation with this admonition used two times, "Worship God!" (Rev. 19:10; 22:8-9) Let us truly have a heart that desires to worship! God loves you and I do too!
