

Remarks From Mark The Power of Edification

One of the vital functions in the body of Christ is edification. To edify from the Greek means "to build up," much like encouragement, which means "to strengthen." When the body of Christ, especially on the congregational level, is functioning properly, edification in love is a result (Eph. 4:11-16). Paul wanted the church in Ephesus to know this. The Holy Spirit wanted us to know this as well. Paul by inspiration of the Holy Spirit lists key ingredients for this to take place. The next few articles will be devoted to each of the ingredients needed for this congregation to be able to "edify itself in love." For West President to be a truly edifying congregation, we need people to fill God-given roles (v.11). We need devotion to the "equipping of the saints for the work of the ministry" (v.12).
