Remarks From Mark

Filling God-given Roles

Last Sunday, we examined the power of edification that is produced when the body of Christ is functioning properly. In (v.11) Paul points out that there are God-given roles in the body that need to be filled. God desires some be apostles. It should be understood that the word apostle simply means “one sent.” While no one can be one of those hand-picked by Jesus, there are those who can fill the role of “one sent” with God’s message of salvation. Missionaries fill this key role. Barnabas was a biblical example of this (Acts 14:14). He, along with Paul, was on a missionary journey together with the message of the gospel. It is NOT a title to be worn, as much as it is a function of the body. There were those with the gift of prophecy in the first century with the ability to foretell the future as well as the past (e.g. Moses writing about creation), but the word simply means “to speak forth.” Preachers do this in a sense, when they speak as the oracles of God (1 Pet. 4:11 i.e. proclaim God’s word). Again, this is not a title to be worn, but a function of the body. Evangelists bring the good news of the gospel (Romans 10:14-17). It should be noted we all can and should play some role in evangelizing the world, whether through supporting, but more importantly sharing Jesus with others, even our families. Pastors are needed. These are more of age and experience who oversee the work of the local congregation as well as shepherd through caring for individuals and setting an example for the congregation to follow (Acts 14:23; 20:17-28; 1 Pet. 5:1-4). Teachers are needed to instruct God’s people in the ways of the Lord (Deut. 6:6-9; Matt. 28:20; 2 Tim. 2:2; Tit. 2:1-8). It should be noted that teaching God’s ways should start in the home. When these God-given roles are filled the saints will be able to minister properly to others and edification will result. I love you all! Grace and peace to you!
