The Purpose of God-given Roles

Last week, we looked at filling the roles God has set forth in the church (Eph. 4:11). This brings us to the threefold purpose God has for these roles (v.12). The first purpose of these roles is “to equip the saints.” This carries the idea of making full preparation or being fully ready. These roles were intended to bring members of the Lord’s church to spiritual maturity by training them the ways of God. Each of these roles as we saw in the last article plays a part in this. The second purpose of these roles is “for the work of the ministry.” The church is to be filled with servants. Ministers are servants. Remember in (Mark 10:43), Jesus said that servants would be greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus Himself did not come to be served, but to serve. Service was a vital function of the 1st century church and should be in the 21st century church as well. The third purpose of these roles is “to edify the body of Christ.” These roles were designed by God to promote spiritual growth of the members of the body of Christ. While some of these roles in the 1st century were miraculous in nature to help bring the church from its infancy, all of these roles can be generally applied to fill the purpose which God designed them for. We all have a need for growth in our lives to press toward the spiritual maturity God desires from each of us. I love you all! Grace and peace to you!
