

# Remarks From Mark The Purpose of God-given Roles

Last week, we looked at filling the roles God has set forth in the church (Eph. 4:11). This brings us to the threefold purpose God has for these roles (v.12). The first purpose of these roles is "to equip the saints." This carries the idea of making full preparation or being fully ready. These roles were intended to bring members of the Lord's church to spiritual maturity by training them the ways of God. Each of these roles as we saw in the last article plays a part in this. The second purpose of these roles is "for the work" of the ministry." The church is to be filled with servants. Ministers are servants. Remember in (Mark 10:43), Jesus said that servants would be greatest in the kingdom of heaven. Jesus Himself did not come to be served, but to serve. Service was a vital function of the 1<sup>st</sup> century church and should be in the 21<sup>st</sup> century church as well. The third purpose of these roles is "to edify the body of Christ."
