

Remarks from Mark "Understanding Our Purpose"

There are a lot of questions facing the Lord's church. One of these questions is why so many congregations are not growing? Tragically, some are even giving up. One of the answers to this alarming question is that the church in many areas simply does not understand its purpose. Some of this comes from not having a complete understanding of evangelism. Often, so much focus is given to (Mark 16:15-16) regarding salvation, that there has been a neglect of (Matthew 28:18-20). Do not misunderstand what was just said, salvation is vitally important, but so is the God-given task of "making disciples" (v.19). Both have eternal consequences. As Christians, especially leaders in the Lord's church, we will give an account for not training new converts (v.20). Regarding this, I came across some interesting quotes: "Full-grown oaks are not produced in three years; neither are servants of God" (Douglas Rumford). The point of this quote is that making disciples is a time-consuming process. Time is something we must be willing to sacrifice for the cause of Christ (Ephesians 5:15-17). "We teach what we know; we reproduce what we are" (Robert Scmidgall). If we are disciples of Christ, that is exactly what we will reproduce. Jesus said Himself, "A disciple that is perfectly trained will be like his teacher" (Luke 6:40). "It would be good if all ministers and leaders had a heavenly instinct for nourishing and bringing up of the Lord's spiritual little ones, but this quality is sadly lacking" (Charles Spurgeon). Paul explained this purpose in (Ephesians 4:11-16; please read). We have a responsibility to grow and help others grow to fulfill our purpose given by the Lord. The future of the Lord's church universally, as well as here at Mayfield depends on this. There are congregations that are thriving today, and it is because they have taken the responsibility of being a true disciple and making other disciples of the Christ. Let us be about fulfilling our purpose here at Mayfield. Remember, God loves you and I do too! Grace and peace to you all!


