“Understanding Grace, Faith, & Good Works, intro.”

In (Ephesians 2:8-10) Paul states, “For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast. For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.” When this passage is mentioned, it typically elicits a response that goes to one of two extremes. On one hand, some people hear this passage and immediately think that salvation is a “give away” with no response on their part, while others go to the other extreme of thinking that they must earn their salvation. In this series of articles, we will strive to show how grace, faith & works go together as the Christian’s proper response to Almighty God for all that He has done for us. All three of these elements are equally important. We look at each one of these elements separately, and then together to see how neatly they fit together in God’s plan for our lives.
