## Remarks from Mark

### ***“Understanding Grace”***

One question that I am sometimes asked is, “What will it take for me to make it to heaven?” Last week, we had an introduction to a series of articles about grace, faith, & good works. Understanding these 3 ingredients will help us have a better knowledge of the above question. When we hear the word ***“grace”*** what comes to mind? The word simply means ***“favor.”*** We live in an age and country where if we want something, we can either buy it or save up enough to later make the purchase. It was not like this for most people in Bible times. In Bible times, there were many basic necessities that common people could not afford. To take it a step further some people were even in slavery because they could not repay a debt. Often, these people would ask a wealthy person for a “favor” to obtain this need. If the wealthy person decided to grant the request, he would then be that person’s benefactor, patron, or even redeemer. The ***“favor”*** given was known as ***“charis,”*** the Greek word from which we get the word, ***“grace.”*** If someone showed you grace, it was your lifelong duty to spread his/her fame and loyally serve them whenever needed. This was not an effort to repay, but the proper response of gratitude.

God’s salvation is like the above scenario. Salvation is a gift from God which we can not repay! (Ephesians 2:8-9) Because God is our gracious Redeemer (Ephesians 2:4-5), we are to spread His fame and serve Him loyally. The proper response to God’s grace, any for that matter, is gratitude. Grace and gratitude have the same root. In Spanish, when one says ***“thank you,”*** the word is ***“gracias.”*** If we are truly grateful for God’s salvation it will be seen in our response to His grace. If I am trying to pay Him back, then I am trying to do the impossible. If I am using His grace as a crutch, then I will do the minimum. If I am truly grateful for His favor, then I will spread His fame and serve Him loyally. Whether or not we make it to heaven, will be determined by our response to His grace. God loves you and so do I! Grace and peace to you!
