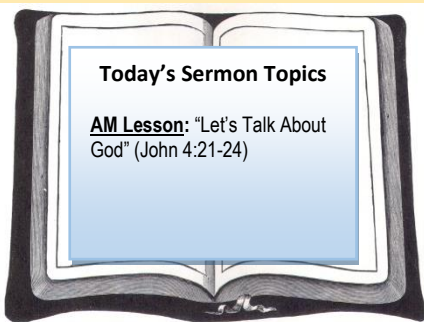

## Acts 5

- I. Ananias and Sapphira punished, and the appointment of those to serve tables while the apostles preached the word of God. (Acts 5)
  - A. Ananias and Sapphira sold a possession of land. (5:1-10)
    1. They kept back part of it, and laid the money at the apostles' feet, supposing to lay it all there, but they kept back part of the money for themselves.
    2. Peter ask Ananias why he lied to the Holy Ghost, and kept back part of the money.
    3. Ananias fell down dead because of his sin of lying to God.
    4. His wife, Sapphira, was asked by Peter about this situation, and she lied as well, and died because of her sin.
    5. Their mistake was not the selling of the land, but their lying about the price, and supposing to lay all the money at the apostles' feet.
