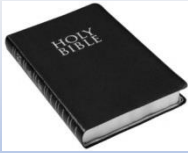

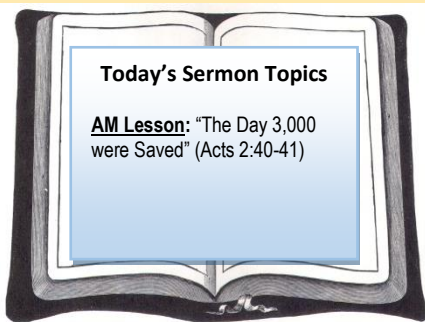

May/June – The Truth About Salvation

Revelation 20

The last three verses of Revelation 19 describe the judgment of Rome and the emperor. Now, Satan will get what is coming to him. This had to be painful for Satan because he is bound and made to watch as God rewards all those slain by Satan.

Verses 1-3 The devil is limited by the gospel of Christ.

Verses 4-6 The martyrs receive their reward. This is the first resurrection.

Verses 7-10 After Rome, the devil will use other wicked people to carry out his wickedness. They will eventually be turned into hell with all his wicked followers.

Verses 11-15 The wicked dead receive their reward. This is the second resurrection. These resurrections are figurative because there is but one general resurrection (John 5:28-29)
